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Moderation Policy

In assessing students' work, Shreeyash Institute of Pharmaceutical Education and Research is committed to continue the good educational practice of moderation in order to ensure that the assessment criteria have been applied correctly and consistently

Careful scrutiny of scripts by someone other than the person originally designated to mark the work. This process involves scrutiny of the consistency and fairness of the marking

Rules For Moderation


1. The process of moderation takes place after all marking has been carried out. Time should be allocated to the process for all summative assessments so that moderation, and any actions from moderation, will be completed prior to the return of grades and/or feedback to students within the agreed time frame.
2. Minimum 5% of total moderation of total answersheet of concerned subject should be assessed for moderation .
3. The moderation should be done with green ball pen only.
4. Changes made by the moderator should be considered only if, the difference between the marks of evaluator and moderator is more than or less than 20%
5. The process of moderation and associated outcomes should be recorded, as part of the record of an assessment and to support transparency and consistency in the steps taken to ensure the quality assurance in the assessment of students' work. This record can be reflected on within the module review process



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Marks Conversions For Smooth Assessment of Student Answersheet

1. The examination pattern for **M. Pharm course** is, 75% marks for University exam and 25% marks are for internal (Institute) assessment.
2. Internal (Institute) theory assessment marks will be decided on the basis of sessional examination.
3. **For M.Pharmacy two theory sessional examinations will be conducted periodically**
 - A. The First sessional examination will be conducted on about 50% of the syllabus and at mid of the semester. The second sessional examination will be conducted on remaining 50% of the syllabus and at the end of the semester.
 - B. As university has allotted only 15 marks for theory sessional exam, but to cover overall syllabus and for better understanding of syllabus theory sessional exam is of 30 marks and then converted into 15 marks.
 - C. Theory internal Assessment (Continuous mode) marks (i.e.10 mark), shall be awarded as per the Attendance (08) & student-teacher interaction.(02)
 - D. The average marks of two sessional examination will be considered as a internal assessment marks (15 Marks) and continuous mode (10 marks) will be forwarded to the university.
